\bigcirc OVERVIEW OF THE LESSON

In this lesson, you will explore a career you are interested in and decide what is acceptable to wear at a job. Then, you will create an infographic that shows professional clothes for your chosen career and a cost comparison chart. The purpose of this lesson is to help you better understand value and opportunity costs of things you may buy in the future to help prepare you for a career.

SUMMARY OF ACTIVITIES

You will start by watching a short video about different kinds of professional work clothes. Then, you will talk with your classmates and share what you thought about professional work clothes.

You will explore professional clothes for the career you chose and put together a workplace outfit and how much it costs in an infographic. This activity will look at the different prices for the same outfit at a discount store, department store, and specialty store. Finally, you will share your infographic with your classmates and talk about which stores you would shop at and why.

Lesson Objectives

- You will be able to tell the difference between types of professional outfits.
- You will be able to research and put together a work-appropriate outfit.
- You will be able to compare the costs of clothing from different stores.
